- (4) During the previous quarter ended 31 December 2015, the Company has provided the diminution, other than temporary in nature, amounting to Rs. 16.43 crores in the carrying value of investments in its subsidiary and same has been utilised against Business Reconstruction Reserve (BRR) by credit to the statement of profit and loss under exceptional items. This utilisation is as per Scheme of Arrangement approved by Hon'ble High Court of Calcutta vide its order dated 26 March 2010 as per which the Company created BRR by revaluation of its certain immovable properties and the said scheme also provide the utilization of credit available in BRR for specific approved purposes as may be deemed necessary and appropriate by Board of Directors of the Company from time to time.
- (5) Previous year's/period's figures have been re-grouped/re-arranged, wherever considered necessary.

- We have audited the annual financial results of HSIL Limited (the 'Company') for the year ended 31 March 2016, attached herewith, being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015. Attention is drawn to note 2 in the annual financial results regarding the figures for the quarter ended 31 March 2016 as reported in these financial results are the balancing figures between the audited figures in respect of the full financial year and the published year to date figures upto the end of the third quarter of the financial year. Also, the figures up to the end of the third quarter had only been reviewed and not subjected to audit. These financial results have been prepared on the basis of the annual financial statements and reviewed quarterly financial results upto the end of the third quarter which are the responsibility of the Company's management. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial results based on our review of financial results for the nine months period ended 31 December 2015 which was prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Accounting Standard 25, Interim Financial Reporting, as specified under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 (the 'Act'), read with Rule 7 of the Companies (Accounts) Rules, 2014 (as amended) and other accounting principles generally accepted in India; and our audit of the annual financial statements which have been prepared in accordance with the accounting principles generally accepted in India, including the Accounting Standards specified under Section 133 of the Act, read with Rule 7 of the Companies (Accounts) Rules, 2014 (as amended).
